

WFNS Skull Base Masterclass is scheduled to be held at the SunSkill training facility on 3-4 December. The workshop will be hosted by the WFNS, Sunskill and will be presented by numerous international proctors including Dr Samy Youssef, Dr Alvaro Campero, Dr Marco Verstegen, Dr Timothy Smith, Dr Doo-Sik Kong and Dr Daniel Prevedello. These colleagues will be supported by an equally qualified cohort of national surgeons with proficiencies in open and endoscopic surgery.

These surgeons are recognised leaders in the field of endoscopic skull base surgery and open skullbase surgery, with many of them members of the WFNS skullbase committee.

This workshop will be *aimed at intermediate and experienced neurosurgeons* who have already mastered the conventional skull base surgeries and have knowledge in and currently performing skull base surgery. The need for further training and exposure to the latest advances is vital if we are to move skull base surgery forward across the globe. The course would be open to participants of the WFNS 2023 congress. In particular we would like to include doctors from low and middle income countries (LMICs).

The programme will extend over **two days** and will consist of a mix of didactics and hand's on cadaver sessions. The opportunity to deliver on highly interactive and complex subject matter is supported by the available technology of endoscopes, navigation, O-Arm and specialised instruments – replicating best international practice.

We can accommodate **sixteen delegates** at this course. Eight teams, each with a dedicated cadaver.
